

Do You Have a Foot Drop Condition?

Foot drop is a common symptom resulting from a CVA or stroke, which results in weakness or paralysis of one side of the body with partial or complete loss of voluntary movement or sensation in a leg or arm. Many patients with foot drop benefit from an AFO or ankle-foot orthosis. The AFO supports the ankle, holds the foot and ankle in the correct position and corrects foot-drop. AFOs or braces are custom-made to a cast of the patients and are fabricated from

a lightweight plastic. In some instances ankle joints are incorporated in the AFO and colors, patterns and cartoons are available upon request. Medical conditions such as cerebral palsy, peripheral neuropathy and multiple sclerosis can also cause lower extremity instability. Covered by health insurance.
